Phonetic correction, verbal practicing through games, tutoring concerning the written communication, comic strip workshop, sociocultural workshop, language and theatre, language and songs, language and cinema, etc.

**A placement test** will be made at the beginning of the course, it will allow you to integrate a level group adapted to your needs.

**A trainee certificate** and an assessment sheet of your level of proficiency will be given to you at the end of the course.
